

## COMMITTEE OF SAFETY SOLUTION

Whether you have been a student with the Sacramento Constitution Group or have realized on your own that something can be done in the saving of our Republic, you are welcome to browse the documents and solutions mentioned here. Hopefully you've found that it is now time to put that education and passion for liberty into action and defend the Republic of California. Multiple generations of lies from the media, and poor education have put us in a terribly compromised position.

From earliest history right up to 1760, a reading of history shows that a few men have always dominated the rest of humanity. There was always slavery in existence of one sort or another. Between 1760 and 1776, colonists in the new world of America were forced into a war which tested their resolve, as well as the resolve and love of their wives and families. And for their courage, fortitude and inspiration we are forever grateful because those courageous men signed a new Declaration of human liberty, unique in all of history. And from that first pronouncement, they went on to form a Republican form of Government giving the people responsibility for keeping their new-found liberty in good health.

However, at this point in history (2023), we find ourselves in nearly the same situation, if not worse as our Founders found themselves in when they separated from England. People up and down the state of California and all over the Republic are hungry for solutions and are feeling powerless in the face of being steam rolled even harder than usual during the last three years, and now the steam roller is amping up its force and fury, running naked to the finish line. Which means those who want control and dominion over the world care not what they have to do to win. They're dropping the deceit they have used for over a hundred years and are ruthlessly breaking the Law of the Land in their incessant grab for world dominance.

The Founders, though, told us in their writings that We the People are the final check and balance on our government. We've forgotten a huge number of principles about this country, embedded in the Constitution, which are still true. They're just waiting to be rediscovered by a critical mass of Americans.

The 1st Principle is that there is a Creator, or Higher Power in this Universe who gave We the People the highest authority in our system of government. The Constitution of the United States and each state constitution since then, were written by a few, but ratified by The People as a whole, to protect our God-given rights to life, liberty and property. The founding documents were written to create the government by declaring to those we appoint through election that they are delegated with only certain duties. In these documents we have told them specifically what they are allowed to do.

Unfortunately, We the People have not enforced the constitutions even once throughout its history, and we've been lulled to sleep by the surge of energy and productivity that liberty sets in motion when allowed.

2nd Principle: The Constitution is the law, and all levels of government are limited by it. If we think it is too difficult to understand, we are wrong. Thomas Jefferson said, "Laws are made for men of ordinary understanding, and should therefore be construed by the ordinary rules of common sense. Their meaning is not to be sought for in metaphysical subtleties which make anything mean everything or nothing, at pleasure."

Upholding the Law of the Land means we acknowledge and look to the Constitution first, before we acknowledge any legislative acts. If any level of government does something that we did not give them authority to do, then it is unlawful. The founders called this "pretend" legislation.

3rd Principle: George Washington said about the Constitution, "Its only keepers are the people." Government workers are public servants, and they cannot be expected to police themselves. That job was given to We the People, since we are the only higher authority, under God, that can hold our servants accountable. This was confirmed as late as 1950 in U.S. Supreme Court Case American Communications Association v. Douds when the court ruled, "It is not the function of our government to keep the citizen from falling into error; it is the function of the citizen to keep the government from falling into error." — U.S. Supreme Court in American Communications Association v. Douds 339 U.S. 382, 442 (1950)

Everyone in the various freedom groups in all 58 counties in California are the keepers of the Constitution. Our freedom is conditional only on our willingness to keep it. And what does that mean? Holding our servants accountable.

4th Principle: So how do we do that? First, we must know what's in the Constitution. In our Constitution Discussion Group we study it according to original intent. Then when we recognize something is unlawful, or that it is pretend legislation, we must choose to not comply so that we're not partaking of the crime. Ignoring pretend legislation is an act of following the law. If we and large numbers of others are successful in ignoring these unjust laws, then we have succeeded, by making it irrelevant

5th Principle: Our right to gather in any size group is the fundamental right we need to hold them accountable. This is why, when the Covid debacle was instigated, many governors went after our right to gather in groups. Social Distancing is doublespeak for destroying our right to assemble. Force, fear and discrimination should be clues that our servants are breaking the law, especially when it comes through mandates, executive orders and unlawful agencies. This is when we need to stand together and let them know that they are breaking the Law of the Land, and we will not acknowledge them, as we are upholding the Law as it is written in the Constitution.

We have seen in history that individuals can many times make a difference on their own. However, when we are gathered into groups, we have the right to tell the government when it is breaking the law, and this gives each individual more power as well as protection. This is part of petitioning for redress. Individuals and groups can all document instances of the usurpation of power. And the larger the group the more

powerful the message received by the servants.

6th Principle: The founders called themselves into groups and set an example of what to do to overthrow a tyrannous government. Towns, counties and colonies from Nova Scotia to Georgia, had their own Committees of Correspondence and/or Committees of Safety. People on these committees wrote to each other to express ideas, to confirm mutual assistance and to debate and coordinate resistance to British imperial policy.

The network created by these committees organized and mobilized hundreds of communities across the colonies. An influential one was called the Loyal 9, started by Samuel Adams by gathering eight friends around him. It kept growing and later became known as the Sons of Liberty. They were the group which instigated the Boston Tea Party, Paul Revere's ride and more. All up and down the colonies Committees were formed outside the king's government. The cream of the crop of leaders from each of the colonies were those who finally met in the First Continental Congress in 1774. And again, in the subsequent Constitutional Congress, the people elected their most knowledgeable representatives to get things straightened out.

This diverse group of men, having studied liberty movements, as well as Common Law in world history, were also inspired by God, or a Higher Power. They thus formed the most unique government in the world, allowing people the freedom to live their conscience and to reach their human potential.

Through this brief story I am introducing the idea of "Committees of Safety" – the very same method that our founding fathers used to take control of their local governments. These "Committeemen" built the nation we inherited, which is now being lost to tyrants. We the People through the true elected Committeemen at the grass roots level can and will (with your participation) take control by starting at the local level and simultaneously on the state level.

Eventually we'll gather with other states going to the federal level of government by simply requiring them to obey the "Supreme Law of the Land" and thereby perform their Constitutional duties. Like most things, it is a simple idea, but not necessarily easy.

It is time to gather all the individual freedom groups in California into larger committees where we can learn to effectively write resolutions and declarations which can be signed by an ever-growing number of groups, representing an even larger number of people who are letting their servants know that we expect them to follow the law, not twist what's already there or change word meanings to suit their greed for power. Organizing and coordinating in this way will allow all of us to participate according to the skills, talents and time we have available

We're just getting our feet wet with the idea of the Committee method they left us. So even though it is a huge task, gathering and documenting the lawlessness we see before us, many hands can make light work as we build our relationships, each contributing our special talent, no matter what it is. Together we are stronger.

Very few of us know what Government by Consent means, and what participation by We the People involves. It's time to start learning, in structurally organized Committees, how many of us really do value liberty for ourselves and our posterity. We've all heard the phrase "There's more of us than there are of them." But it certainly doesn't feel like it, does it. They are using Natural Law tools to their advantage. But we can learn to use those same tools to our advantage.

This is an ideological battle, and the other side is organized, has money and controls the media. We can learn to create our own media, do deep diving research, organize and use the principles I just went through to restore the Republic.
